

Please check the following requirements before you start with FileDirector installation:


- 1. Latest Windows updates should be installed
- 2. Machine name should not be "fd-server"
- 3. User account as member of local administrator group
- 4. Create additional account "fd-server" as member of administrators or domain administrator (depends on use) for FileDirector internal use
- 5. User Account Control (UAC) must be deactivated






6. Web Server (IIS) must be installed
